COURSE OVERVIEW

The Concordia Hospital in Rome performs 400 arthroscopies every year. 70% of those surgeries are shoulder (cuff and instability), 30% are knee (all kinds) and 10% are ankle and elbow. Two teaching clinicians are available to instruct every day. Teaching center participants work two days a week in surgery, two days a week in the office, and two days a week in research.

Trainees have access to the most advanced shoulder and elbow arthroscopic techniques. The training period runs for three months, commencing in September.

Most of the fellows are from Italy and are interested in learning arthroscopic techniques and sports medicine.

The teaching team at Concordia Hospital consists of Dr. Giovanni Di Giacomo and Dr. Alberto Constantini. They are in charge of the ATP Italian Tennis Tournament (the Italian Open), as well as the Davis Cup.
